The University was established on 28th March 2022 under the Private Higher Educational Institutions Act 1996 (Act 555). The University is the first Malaysian institution specializing in Cooperative Entrepreneurship and Management Studies. It strives to be a leader in transforming and producing more professionals in the cooperative sector.

COURSE OVERVIEW

The Graduate Business School of UKKM now offers MBA programme specializing in Cooperative Management. Our MBA programme is designed to advance managerial skills and develop their potential to be able to manage organisations effectively in this dynamic and complex environment. Ultimately, it is aimed at cultivating a range of skills and expertise required for higher managerial positions and enhance their career prospect. Graduates are required to complete a total of 46 credit hours. STUDY MODES

The programme available in both full time and part time.

Full time: Minimum period of study - 1 Year 6 Months

Part time: Minimum period of study – 2 Years 6 Months (Malaysian Only)

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- A Bachelor's degree in Cooperative Management and any related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.50; or
- A Bachelor's degree in related fields with a minimum CGPA below 2.50 can be accepted, subject to a rigorous internal assessment; or
- A Bachelor's degree in non-related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 and with relevant working experience, subject to a rigorous internal assessment; or
- A Bachelor's degree in non-related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 and without relevant working experience, subject to passing pre-requisite courses; or
- Other equivalent/related qualifications to a Bachelor's degree recognised by the Malaysian Government
